The SUN-Day rally: a fun scenic way to get lost in Rockland County

Starting at the Palisades Center Mall in Nyack on Sunday, 7/17/05 at Noon.

WHAT: This Time/Speed/Distance rally will be a low pressure driving event where a car is driven with a driver and a navigator following set instructions at an average speed. Any wrong turns "off course" of the instructions and the team must get back on course and make up time to stay on the average speed for the rally. Points are given for time late or early to each checkpoint and missing marking down the hidden rally signs along the course. This is not a race, you are expected to follow all laws and regulations while driving. While competitive, the main objective is to have a fun drive on fun roads. Skill is shown on arriving at the perfect time to checkpoints and not missing any hidden signs. Trophies will be distributed to the top finishers and winners of special classes like "family" or "husband/wife". New to rallies? There will be a novice class with easier instructions.

WHERE: The commuter parking lot outside the main road of the Palisades Mall road, opposite Home Depot.

WHEN: Registration will open at Noon. Drivers meeting at 12:30. First car off at 1pm and each car will leave in 1-minute intervals. Expect two to three hours of driving.

HOW: You need a registered street car with at least two people. You should arrive with a full tank of gas and probably a full stomach. A pen, something to write on the navigator's lap like a clipboard, a calculator, and scrap paper are recommended. Drinks and candy/chocolate/sugar are highly recommended. There will be a restaurant/bar near the finish where ralliists can collaborate and curse the rally master.

WHO: Westchester Sports Car Club has been putting on rallies and autocrosses since 1949. We have 4 to 5 rallies a year, mostly night rallies in Westchester. See www.wsccl.org for details or call the rally master at 201-543-3554 (Mike) with questions.

WHY: Rallies are a lot of fun: Great drives down great roads. Good scenery on challenging, twisty roads. Trying to interpret the instructions and staying on course (driver/navigator arguments). Staring at the side of the road for clues and trying to remember the next turn (the SUNNY clue sign stare). Passing other ralliists going in the wrong direction (making fun of others when you're doing well).
