WHAT IS A RALLY?

Basically a rally is a timed scavenger hunt on tiny backroads

RULES OF THE RALLY

This is a low pressure timed rally starting and ending in Westchester County. Entrants should have a light for reading route instructions, a watch, paper and a pen or pencil as well as something to write on (such as a clip board). A four function calculator may be helpful. No auxiliary lights above headlight level will be needed or allowed. (Note that New York state law prohibits such lights) No hand held spot lights, please. No alcoholic beverages allowed before or during the rally. More than two people in a car will be appropriately penalized. No driver-only cars will be allowed.

TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded to top 10%. (To qualify for an award, the team has to finish.) A WSCC Credit Certificate (good for free entry at any WSCC event) may be chosen in place of a traditional trophy. Dash Plaques will be given to all entrants.
